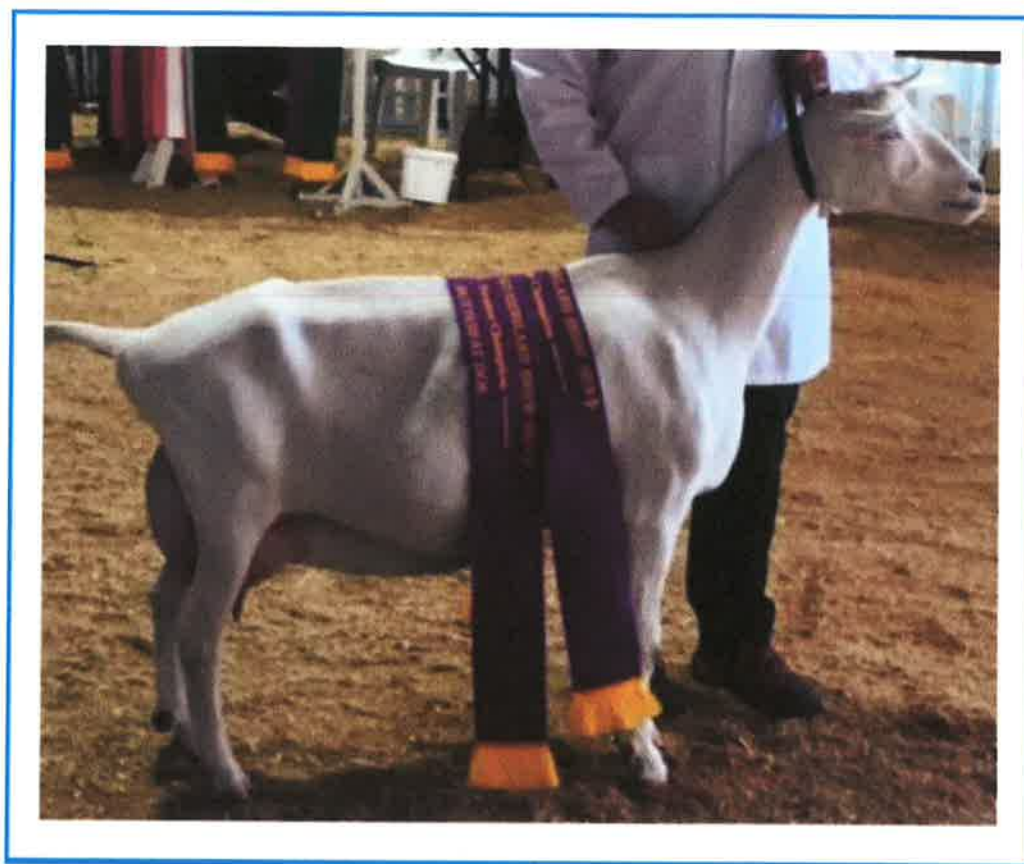

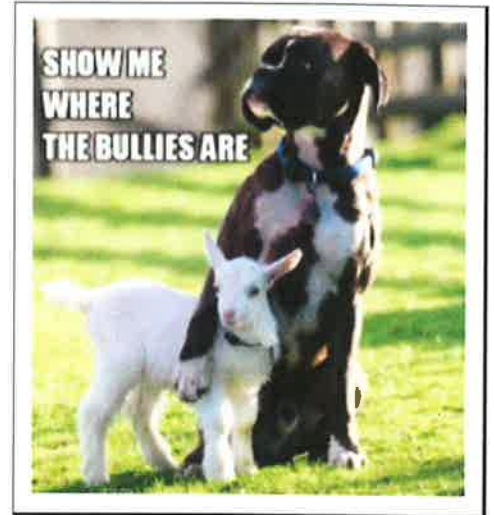

Judge's Training Program

Members of Queensland and other Branches are invited to register for the next Judge's Training Program to be conducted by this Branch.

The program will be offered in four parts, including an online or home study component, as outlined below:

Part / Stage	Approximate Timeframe	Component	Comment
1	November – December 2019	Self-paced study of the Australian Breed Standards for all 10 recognised breeds.	Requirements will be forwarded when member has registered. Mentoring and branch support offered.
2	January – February 2020	Course work including judging technique, using point cards, terminology, evaluating faults, handling disqualifications, validating placings and specifics to breeds and bucks, does and kids.	Ideally this will be a two-day workshop held in a centre central to most participants, or through home study and coaching. <i>Note:</i> preference is for the group workshop.
3	February – March 2020	Practical handling workshop and practical judging exam.	Held on one-day. <i>Note:</i> more than one venue may be needed.
4	March 2020	Written exam.	To be conducted as a group or individually with an approved supervisor to certify the exam was conducted appropriately.

Costs for the course are to be met by the participating member, with branch costs being kept to a minimal amount.

Milk Production Recording and 24-Hour Testing

Recording milk production is easy, worth the small amount of time it takes one day per month, inexpensive and adds great value to the doe's credentials and those of her offspring.

Recording can be done as a supervised independent recording or through farmer own sampling.

An up-to-date list of approved milk testers is published in this newsletter.

Having your own scales makes the process much easier.

Although the Queensland Branch has two sets of milk testing equipment available for loan, members are encouraged to buy their own.

Scales are reasonably inexpensive, such as those advertised on The Farmers Mailbox website. These are 10kg capacity dial hanging scales, with 50g increments and cost about \$69.


Digital scales are also widely available, but must be calibrated in kilograms with .05 divisions (see the regulations on pg 204, 2018 Herd Book)

Most shows have a type and production class for herd recording and another for 24hr tests and are very worthwhile classes.

See page 9 & 10 of the 2019 Branch Book for getting started with Herd Recording or for booking a 24hr test.
