There has been a 6 month extension for AGM's to be held within the need for written approval:

### Incorporated associations, charities and not-for-profits

The [Associations Incorporation Act 1981](#) requires an association's annual general meeting (AGM) to be held within 6 months of the end of their financial year. There is an existing provision in the Act (s. 121) that allows the chief executive to grant an extension to an association for holding its AGM.

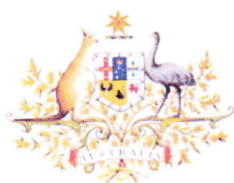
Normal practice is that an individual association must apply to OFT, outlining the special circumstances as to why the extension should be granted. However, in the current circumstances, we will allow a grace period of a further 6 months to hold your AGM, if required, without the need for you to make a written application.

In effect, this may result in a management committee's term being longer than is described in the rules, but, given the current circumstances, we hope members will be accepting of this.

## Australian Champion Tollendool Karamella \*Q\*7

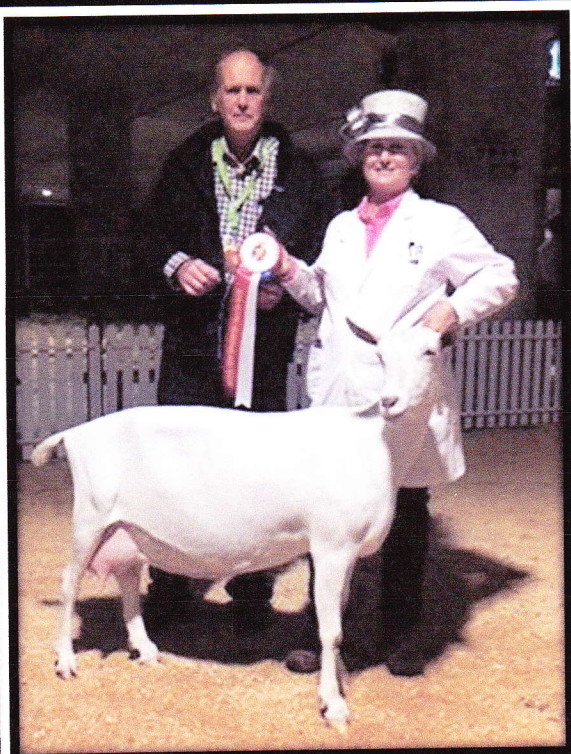



## REMINDER FOR SHOW STEWARDS AND EXHIBITORS

Please be reminded that the legislation regarding stock movement changed and different forms are to be used when moving your stock. There seems to be some confusion regarding what the new requirements are. Basically all stock movements need to be recorded, and that includes taking stock to shows. STEWARDS: Show societies can be audited, and it is your responsibility to ensure all the required paperwork is collected and retained for the show society and if it is a Branch Show the paperwork is to be forwarded to the Branch Secretary to be held for future reference. What is needed is a copy of the stock movement forms for each exhibitor, any health statement forms for those exhibitors on the GoatMAP scheme, the Show Sale and Exhibition certificate of compliance document, and the CRV certificates.

If using the Movement Record, you need to keep a copy for yourself and give one to the steward. The NVD prints out in triplicate. This document replaces the old Waybill that was purchased in booklet form.

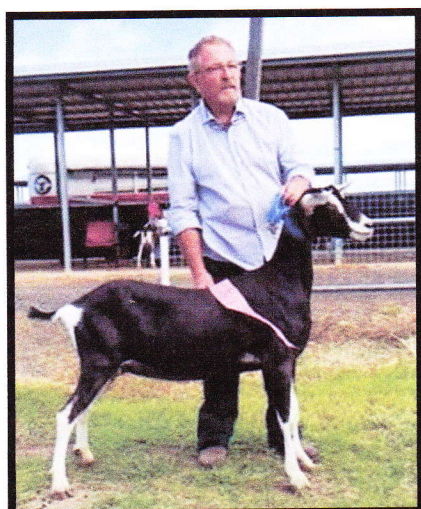

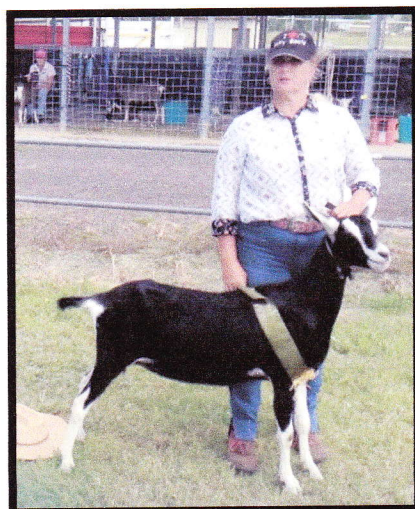

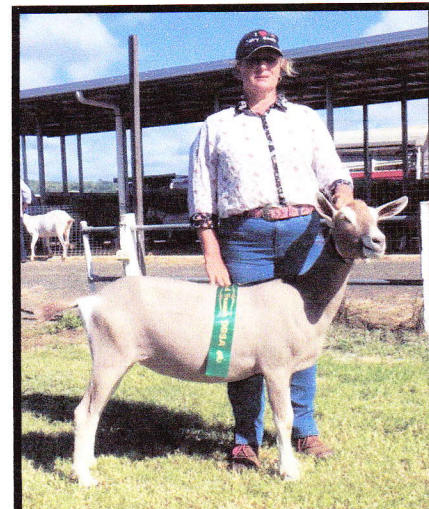
